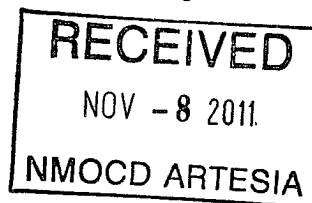

BHP Petroleum is receipt of Compliance Order No. 04-074-11W. The BLM, Roswell Field Office, granted on August 17, 2011 a 90-day extension for the reclamation of exposed plastic, saturated soils in the pit area and the access road.

BHP Petroleum is requesting an extension of time until November 30, 2011 to complete the corrective actions outlined in the compliance order.

BHPB currently has no activity in the surrounding area therefore needing the extension to access the site and safety and effectively complete the work.
