The produced fluids releases at this site are numerous and have been occuring for a period of possibly years with no remediation of any kind indicated. A fiberglass tank at one of the tank batterys is leaking at time of inspection. This site is in violation of Rule 116, Rule 13 and Rule 103. Leak is to

be repaired immediately.

No action has been taken to bring well into compliance. Area at wellhead and out into pasture is heavily contaminated. This is in violation of Rule 13 and Rule 116 and shows a pattern of willfull and knowing violation of NMOCD Rules and Regulations. This type of action can lead to further enforcement actions. Well is also in violation of Rule 103 for no well sign.
