

Subject: Lease Termination, Last Production, Lease NM-37604

Lease NM-37604, a 10-year lease dated August 1, 1980, was extended by diligent drilling operations to July 31, 1992, had first production on October 12, 1990, and therefore has been in its extended term by production since July 31, 1992.

The last producible well on the lease, Abo Petroleum Corporation's Well No. 1-Boomer Federal located 1650 FSL and 330 FWL Sec. 10, T. 15 S., R. 29 E., Chaves County, New Mexico had not produced since October 2007. The certified letter dated April 30, 2010 was received May 5, 2010, provided the operator sixty (60) days in which to commence testing, reworking, or drilling operations.

A Notice of Intent to Plug Back and Recomplete well No. 1-Boomer Federal was approved June 10, 2010 subject to commencing work on or before July 4, 2010 and operations were to be conducted safely with no damage to the surface. Operations to plug back and recomplete were commenced June 11, 2010 and ceased June 30, 2010 without production being restored. Well No. 1-Boomer Federal was plugged on December 10, 2010 and the downhole plugging was approved January 6, 2011. An APD for well No. 2-Boomer Federal in Sec. 10, T. 15 S., R. 29 E. on lease NM-37604 was approved July 1, 2010. However, drilling operations have not been commenced and the APD has expired.

Without production or other activity to extend it, lease NM-37604 is considered to have expired June 30, 2010, the day operations to plug back and recomplete ceased without production being restored.

Bond coverage under Abo Petroleum Corporation's \$25,000.00 Statewide BLM Bond No. NM2098 for the State of New Mexico should be maintained until the final abandonment of their well No. 1-Boomer Federal on lease NM-37604 has been approved. The Roswell Field Office will advise when such action has been completed.
