Dear Mr. Campanella:

Reference is made to your request dated May 16, 2005, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Oxy T-Bone Federal Well No. 1. This request is based on a step rate injection test that was conducted on the well on May 4, 2005. The step rate test data shows that approval of the request will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:
