5/10/05 Set composite plug at 8900'.
5/11/05 Tested casing 4200' to plug with 1000 psi, tested good. Tested casing from surface to 781', tested good. Tested from 781'-945', did not test. Try to circulate up 8-5/8" from 781' and held 1000 psi. Perforated squeeze holes at 3940'. Set cement retainer at 3900'.
5/12/05 Cement casing from 3940' to surface. Pumped 800 sx "C" Neat cement. Did not get cement to surface.
5/16/05 Drilled up cement retainer and cement. Circulated clean. Tested casing to 500 psi for 30 min.
5/17/05 Top of cement 900'. Perforate Lower Canyon 7849'-7863' (90). Set packer at 7647'.
5/18/05 Acidize Canyon with 1500g 7-1/2% MSA acid.
