


Michelle,

The above abandoned well location was inspected 11/12/12. A few minor issues were identified and will need some attention prior to Final Abandonment. We have concerns with a poly flow running along the reclaimed access road with some traffic on the reclamation to lay the line. This will become a new compacted road if left as is. There is a pipe riser of some sort west of the DHM that will need to be removed. For the most part the pit area is looking good. However, there are a couple of barren areas that may have some minor salt impact and may need additional remediation at some point. Lastly, there are some minor amounts of trash that needs to be removed.

My suggestion is to monitor for a growing season, then check for salt impacts to the location and the pit area and take remedial action as needed. At that time the post and miscellaneous trash/debris should be removed. Then continue to monitor until such time as objectives are met.
