**CULTURAL RESOURCES STIPULATIONS
CARLSBAD FIELD OFFICE**

PROJECT NAME: Cultural Resource Survey of a pad and access road for the Anadarko Pardue Farms "ANQ" Fed. Com well No. 2 and the Pan AM Pardue "ALZ" Fed. Com well no. 3.

REPORT NUMBER: 04-NM-080-252

SITE PROTECTION AND EMPLOYEE EDUCATION: All employees of the project shall be informed that cultural sites are to be avoided by all personnel, personal vehicles and company equipment. They shall also be notified that it is illegal to collect, damage or disturb cultural resources.

YES A. Monitoring is required.

YES 1. A copy of these stipulations shall be supplied to the archaeological monitor at least five (5) working days prior to the start of construction activities.

YES 2. No construction activities, including vegetation removal, may begin before the arrival of the archaeological monitor.

YES 3. The archaeological monitor will:

YES a. Ensure that the site protection barrier is located as indicated on the attached map(s).

YES b. Observe all surface disturbing activities within 100 feet of cultural site LA 134,105 (see attached maps).

NO c. Other:

YES d. Submit a report of the monitoring activities within thirty (30) days of completion of monitoring unless other arrangements are made with the BLM. These stipulations must be attached to the report.

NO B. The grantee must select one of the following alternatives:

NO 1. Controlled test excavations to determine if cultural resources are present;

NO 2. Reduction of the project size to avoid all significant cultural materials;

NO 3. Relocation of the project;

NO 4. Preparation and implementation of a data recovery plan for cultural sites(s)

YES C. SITE BARRIER/FENCING:

YES 1. A temporary site protection barrier(s) shall be erected prior to access road construction. The barrier(s) shall, at a minimum, consist of upright wooden survey lath spaced no more than ten (10) feet apart and marked with blue ribbon flagging or blue paint. (May use other type of fencing such as orange flagging depending upon terrain). There shall be no construction activities or vehicular traffic past the barrier(s). The barrier(s) shall remain in place through reclamation and reseeding.

NO 2. A permanent fence(s) shall be erected prior to _____ construction. There shall be no construction activities or vehicle traffic past the fence(s).

YES 3. The barrier(s)/fence(s) shall be placed as indicated on the attached map(s).

YES D. CONSTRUCTION ZONES: There shall be a no construction zone (see maps).
