

Due to both and alarm failure and haul trucks not being available to haul oil, the oil tank overflowed. Have haul trucks arrive early and replaced the transducers on the alarm.					
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*					
Initially 6bbls of oil were released from the oil tank inside the tank battery due to oil trucks running late and alarm failure. We were able to recover 3bbls of oil with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
