Water leg on gun barrel developed a leak around the bottom collar. The collar has been replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Initially 40bbbls of produced water were released from the water leg on the gun barrel. We were able to recover 40bbbls with a vacuum truck. The release was completely contained inside the lined facility walls of the tank battery. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. The facility has been returned to its prior condition.
