

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
A leak in the 3 inch poly gas/water line from the facility to the main gas gathering system caused 122 bbls of produced water to spill onto the ground. 120 bbls of produced water were recovered via vacuum truck and the line was repaired or replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The affected area is approximately 5' x 100'. Remediation will be completed in accordance with a remediation plan approved by NMOCD.
