Initially, 1/4bbl of oil and 10bbls of produced water were released due to a water hauler driving off without disconnecting the load line. We were able to recover 1/4bbl of oil and 10bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we has replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
