1. Due to being within the Lesser Prairie Chicken habitat, this workover activity will be restricted to the hours of 9:00am through 3:00am for the period of March 1 through June 15. Exceptions to these restrictions may be granted by BLM's Johnny Chopp <jchopp@blm.gov> 575.234.2227 or Bob Ballard <bballard@blm.gov> 575.234.5973.
2. Surface disturbance beyond the existing pad must have prior approval
3. File a **subsequent sundry** Form 3160-5 within 30 days of well work. Include an updated wellbore diagram. File the subsequent sundry for the well stimulation separately if it is delayed as much as 25 days.
4. Submit the BLM Form 3160-4 **Recompletion Report** within 30 days of the date all BLM approved procedures are complete.
5. Workover approval is good for 90 days (completion to be within 90 days of approval). A legitimate request is necessary for extension of that date.
