Gentlemen:

Your Application for Permit to Drill (APD), approved November 23, 2011, for the Drickey Queen Sand Unit #703, (SHL: 10 FNL & 1309 FEL) Section 10, T14S R31E Chaves County, NM. Federal lease LC-068474 has *expired* November 23, 2013 because drilling has not commenced within two years of the approval date.

Please note on the resubmitted APD that it was previously approved and we will review the expired file for information which *may* expedite the processing.
