The packing was replaced. Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The spill impacted approximately 2300 sq.ft. of caliche well pad and approximately 1500 sq. ft of pasture. All of the free standing fluid was recovered with a vacuum truck. The stained area on the pad and pasture was left as is pending response activities.
