On May 29, 2015 6:30 AM the Cowpens 28 Fed Com 1 was struck by lightning and the tanks caught on fire. Once on location it was discovered that this caused a release of 99bbbls produced water into lined containment. The Loco Hills Fire Department, Carlsbad Fire Department and La Huerta Fire Department all responded to the incident and were able to extinguish the fire.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The location had three tanks and all three tanks were burned no oil was lost and all 99bbbls produced water were recovered by vac truck. The liner was checked and no holes were found. The location will be cleaned up and rebuilt.
