
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

A dump valve on a separator was stuck open, causing the release. Vacuum truck(s) and roustabout crews were called.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

An approximate area of 50' X 50' was affected within the unlined/bermed battery. The valves were closed and all of the crude oil and produced water was recovered (100%). A roustabout crew was called to make repairs on the separator. Impacted soils will be excavated/hailed to a NMOCD approved facility. **Depth to Ground Water: > 100' (approximately 110', per Chevron/Texaco Trend Map); Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: > 1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.**
