Dear Mr. Sirgo:

Reference is made to your request received by the Division on November 8, 2005, to increase the surface injection pressure on the North Square Lake Unit Well No. 69 within the North Square Lake Unit Pressure Maintenance Project. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on this well on November 7, 2005. The results of the step rate test show that an increase in the surface injection pressure for this well is justified and will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:
