Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

An accumulation of spills and leaks over the years by BirdCreek Resources. This facility was purchased by Chesapeake Operating in early 2005 and Chesapeake assumed control of the investigation and remediation plans. Samples were taken and a remedial plan was submitted to the NMOCD-Artesia and approved.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

A new SWD facility was constructed next to the old facility and the old facility was dismantled. After dismantling, the impacted soil beneath the old facility was excavated to a depth of 3 feet and disposed of at CRI. A 40 mil plastic liner was then placed into the excavation and was backfilled and compacted to grade. The remediation was completed on September 26, 2005.
