

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Transport driver broke the valve seal on the produce water tank. A vacuum truck was immediately called in to collect the water. Fluid release was contained on the facility pad.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Assessment performed at the release. Submitted the Work Plan Report to the NMOCD for review. The extent of the spill area measured approx. 35' x 90'. All TPH and BTEX samples collected during the assessment were below the RRAL. A Closure Report was submitted the NMOCD for review.
