This release was caused by a check valve failure on a flowline inside the containment. A vacuum truck was dispatched to recover the standing fluid inside the containment.

This release occurred within the lined containment. Concho will have the spill site inspected for any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
