
A faulty transfer pump on the piping caused a leak of 1100 bbls of produced water to leak both on and off location. A vacuum truck recovered 900 bbls of produced water and the pump was repaired/replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The affected area is approximately 750' x 200' both on and off location. Remediation will be completed in accordance with the remediation plan approved by both NMOCD and the BLM.
