Mechanical failure of an 8" poly frac line caused a leak of 185 bbls of produced water. A vacuum truck recovered 170 bbls and the line was put back in service.

The affected area is approximately 120' x 80' on the location pad. Remediation will be completed in accordance with a remediation plan approved by NMOCD and the BLM.
