

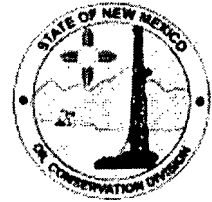

The following options are available:

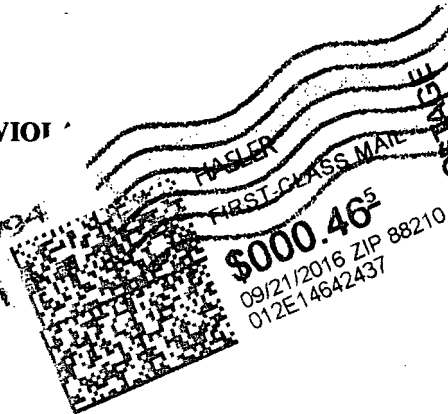
