We will put and compact a layer of caliche on top of the pit to cap the chlorides down and then come back with a thick layer of good topsoil over the caliche cap. Once complete the new top soil will be reseed with BLM #2.

Casey,

Per our phone conversation, the current well pad interim reclamation plan is approved by Shelly Tucker provided a full reclamation of the pit area takes place. A full reclamation of the pit area means:

1. Scrape the top 0-18" of contaminated soil. Cap the pit with a plastic liner. Then put a minimum of 18" caliche and topsoil back on the cap, and reseed when appropriate. Any areas above grade must be blended into

the surrounding landscape. Shelly also noted that you may want to fence the reclamation as we have had problems with cattle destroying IRs as of late.
