PROJECT NAME: Poker Lake Unit #219 well location and access road

DATE: 5/10/2005

SITE PROTECTION AND EMPLOYEE EDUCATION: All employees of the project and subcontractors shall be informed that cultural sites are to be avoided by all personnel, personal vehicles and company equipment. They shall also be notified that it is illegal to collect, damage or disturb cultural resources.

YES A. Monitoring is required.

YES 1. A copy of these stipulations shall be supplied to the archaeological monitor at least five (5) working days prior to the start of construction activities.

YES 2. No construction activities, including vegetation removal, may begin before the arrival of the archaeological monitor.

YES 3. The archaeological monitor will:

YES a. Ensure that the site protection barrier is located as indicated on the attached map.

YES b. Observe all disturbing activities within 100 feet of cultural sites LA 147354, and LA 147931.

YES c. Other: Monitor the initial construction of the access road, well pad, and pit.

YES d. Submit a report of the monitoring activities within thirty (30) days of completion of monitoring unless other arrangements are made with the BLM. These stipulations must be attached to the report.

NO B. The grantee must select one of the following alternatives:

NO 1. Controlled test excavations to determine if cultural resources are present;

NO 2. Reduction of the project size to avoid all significant cultural materials

NO 3. Relocation of the project;

NO 4. Preparation and implementation of a data recovery plan for cultural sites(s)

YES C. SITE BARRIER/FENCING:

YES 1. A temporary site protection barrier(s) shall be erected prior to construction. The barrier(s) shall, at a minimum, consist of upright wooden survey lath spaced no more than ten (10) feet apart and marked with blue ribbon flagging or blue paint. There shall be no construction activities or vehicular traffic past the barrier(s). According to the APD the pits are going to be constructed to the east. Therefore, to ensure LA 147354 is not impacted by the construction of the pits and/or any other activity a temporary barrier is required to be installed prior to construction can commence.

NO 2. A permanent fence shall be erected prior to construction. There shall be no construction activities or vehicle traffic past the fence. **An archaeologist shall monitor the construction of the fence.**

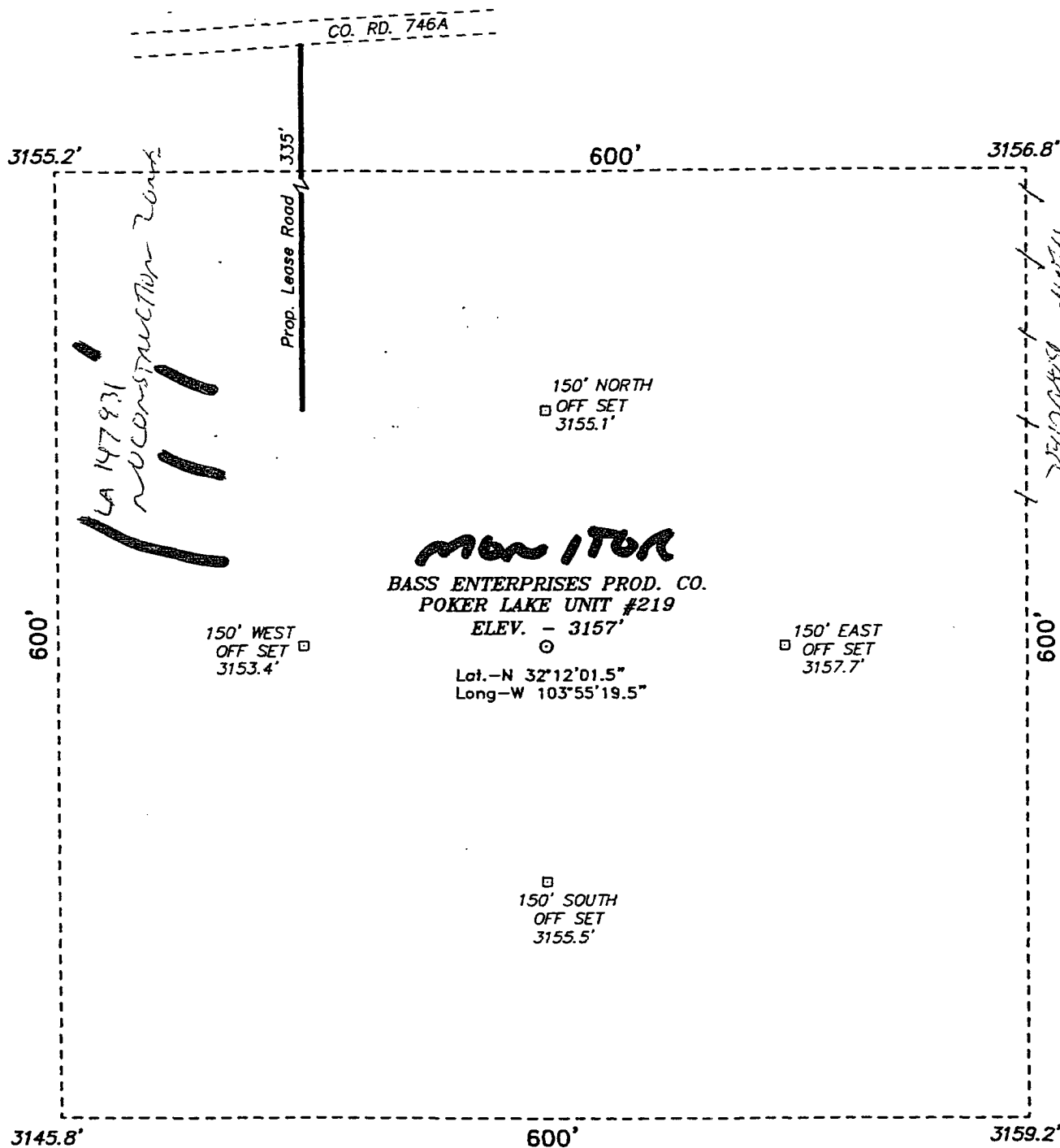
YES 3. The barrier/fence shall be placed as indicated on the attached map.

YES D. CONSTRUCTION ZONES: No construction zone allowed within the cultural sites.

Ensure there is no construction activity, staging area, etc. within
LA 147931 and LA 147354.

YES E. OTHER: If subsurface cultural material is observed while monitoring the access road, well location, or pit area, construction shall cease immediately in the given area and a BLM-CFO archaeologist shall be notified immediately. The area of concern shall be flagged off with blue surveyors flagging tape with a minimum 100 foot buffer zone. Construction and monitoring may continue outside the flagged buffer zone.
