Chevron USA respectfully requests the following changes to the approved APD:

- EDS PME: The required Primary Metering Equipment location is outside of the permitted region. In order to fully energize the Chevron Electric Distribution System (EDS) a 160.07' section of EDS line is required. This section of EDS line will be used to connect the Primary Metering Equipment from the 3rd Party Power supplier to the permitted section of the EDS line. Once the Chevron EDS system is connected to the Power supplier's PME and is fully energized, the Central Tank Battery and Compressor Station can receive power and process production from the wells. Without the fully energized EDS system, the facilities will be unable to operate and unable to process the fluids. This proposed EDS line will be overhead.

- EDS CONNECTION TO IT TOWER: The EDS system was not connected to the IT Tower around the permitted SWD Facility in the original APD Submission. As such, the permitted IT Tower won't be able to receive line power and will not operate and communicate with the facilities and wells. A proposed 567.34' section of EDS line would connect the permitted EDS line around the permitted SWD Facility and provide power to the IT Tower. With a fully powered IT Tower, communications can be sent to and from the Central Tank Battery and Compressor Station, allowing them to operate reliably. Without a fully powered IT Tower, the Central Tank Battery and Compressor Station will be unable to reliably operate for an extended period of time and will be unable to process well fluids. This proposed EDS line will be overhead
