COMMINGLING ORDER CTB-535-A

The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle and sell off-lease Southwest Willow Lake-Delaware (Oil - 96855) Pool gas production from the following Eddy County, New Mexico leases:

Devon Fee Lease Falcon "10" Well No. 1 API No. 30-015-32571 Red Tailed Hawk "10" Well No. 1 API No. 30-015-32773 S/2 NE/4 and N/2 NW/4 of Section 10;

State Lease No. VA-1722
Peregrine "10" Well No. 1 API No. 30-015-32312
SE/4 SE/4, W/2 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4, and N/2 NE/4 of Section 10; and

State Lease No. V-5284 Eagle "4" State Well No. 1 API No. 30-015-32569 S/2, E/2 NE/4 and NW/4 of Section 4;

all located in Township 25 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Gas, and water production shall be separately measured for each lease and allocated to each well within each lease based on periodic well tests. Oil shall not be commingled.

Gas production shall be commingled and sold from a CDP located in the SW/4 of Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority. The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of commingling operations.
