This well has a BLM approved drilling permit(3160-3 dated 12/22/2006) for a drilling TD of 5400'. We have spudded and are presently drilling. We request premission to amend the total drilling depth to 6000' in order to test a lower portion of the Cedar Lake, Yeso formation.

We will set the 7" 23# production casing to this 6000' depth and cement as per the BLM approval stipulations in place. This is a planned vertical well.
