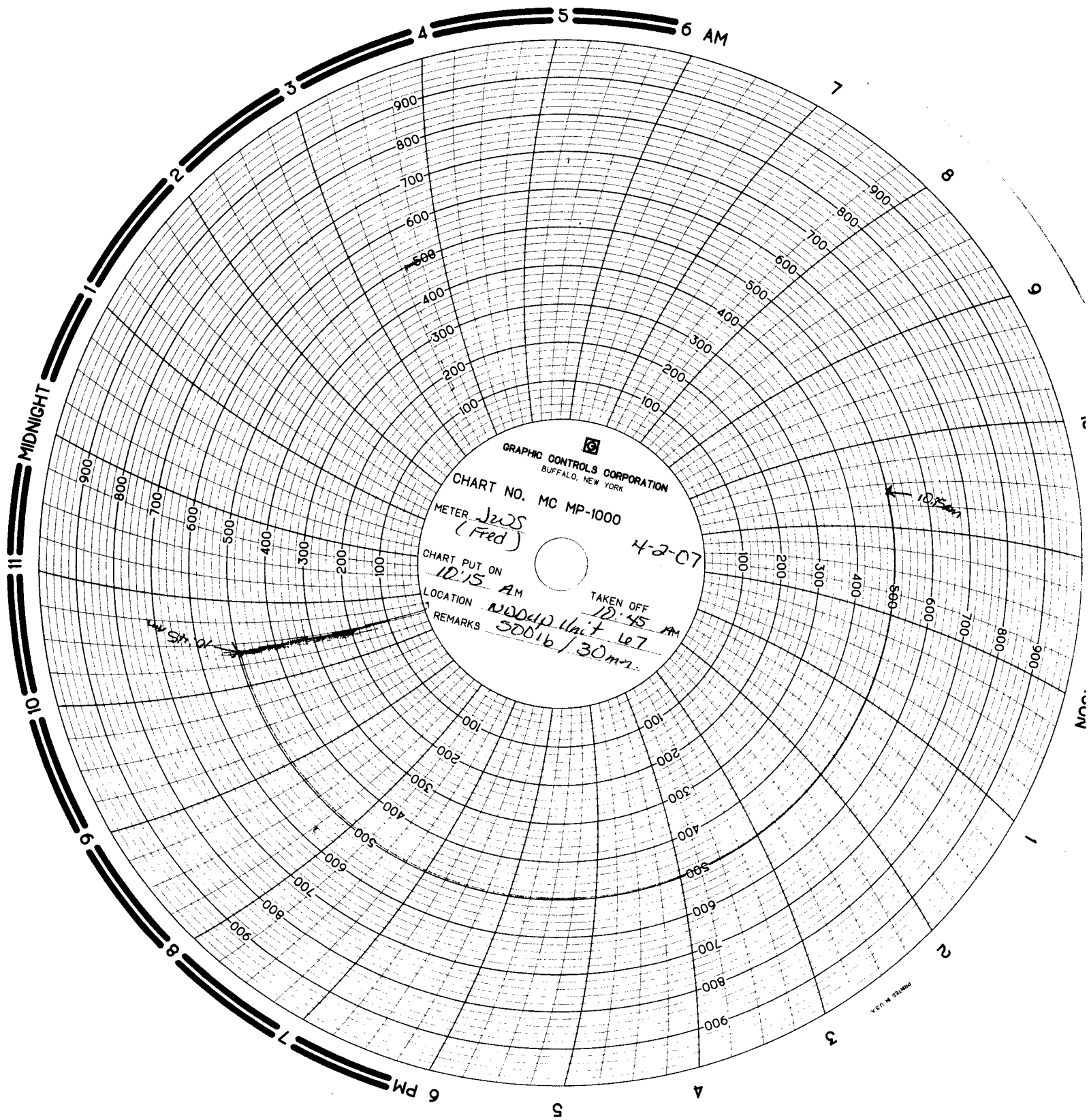

Stipulations for Temporary Abandonment

1. Under the provisions of Rule 19.15.9.705 NMAC:

Abandonment of Injection Operations

- (1) Whenever there is a continuous one year period of non-injection into any injection project, storage project, **salt water disposal well**, or special purpose injection well, such project or well shall be considered abandoned, and the authority for injection shall automatically terminate ipso facto.
2. Last reported production was in 1995 and well has been inactive since that time. Any request for reinstatement of the injection authority must be submitted to NMOCD Santa Fe, NM for Division approval.
