Apache Corporation ("Apache") owns the operating rights in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 12, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, which is covered by Federal Lease #NM 23002. On March 15, 2007, and without Apache's consent, Marbob Energy Corporation ("Marbob") filed an Application for Permit to Drill (see attached) a horizontal well (Malibu Federal #2) which Marbob claims will have an 80 acre dedicated spacing unit (E/2 NE/4 Section 12-T19S-R31E). The surface location is located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 12-T19S-R31E where Apache owns 100% of the operating rights.
