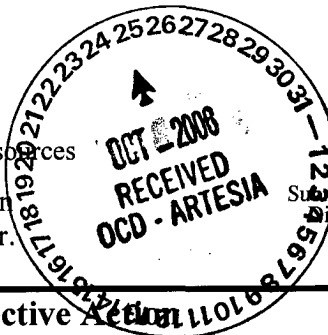

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Storage Tank overflow was the cause of part of the release. A small hole in the side of one of the tanks was also found. Added oil storage tank and upgraded SWD system. Also fixed the hole in the side of the tank.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The affected area consisted of inside the bermed area and in front of the tank battery where the trucks load. Contaminated soils were excavated and transported to CRI. The excavation was then backfilled.
