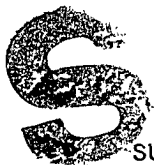

6/5/07 Spotted 60 sx cement at 1253'. Circulated up 8-5/8" and pressure up to 900 psi - per Paul Swartz. WOC and tagged at 981'. Perforated at 60'. Circulated 25 sx cement to surface.

6/6/07 Cut off wellhead. Installed dry hole marker. **WELL IS PLUGGED AND ABANDONED. FINAL REPORT.**
