The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of a remediation work plan proposal (plan) for clean up a release of produced fluids that occurred at the above referenced well site on or about December 6, 2005. The plan was formulated by your agent, Environmental Plus Inc.

The plan is approved as presented with the following stipulations:

- Notify the OCD 24 hours prior to commencement of activities.
- Notify the OCD 24 hours prior to obtaining samples where analyses of samples obtained are to be presented to the OCD.
- Submit a Final Report C-141 upon satisfactory completion of project.
- Like approval by BLM on Federal surface areas.

Please be advised that this approval does not relieve Chevron USA Inc. of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that may pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, this approval does not relieve Chevron USA Inc. of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and/or regulations.
