On May 22, 2007 the OCD sampling crew along with Rand French from Marbob Energy Corp. participated in a pit sampling program. At the time this specific drilling pit was not on a random list of pits to be sampled. Marbob Energy Corp. offered to sample this pit and at that time we found two areas where the pit liner had been compromised. As a result of this finding and conversations thereafter, Marbob Energy Corp. is submitting this C-141.

On 6/6/07 Marbob Energy Corp. had a meeting with the Artesia district office staff to decide what actions for official notice and closure would be taken on this potential release that may have contained drilling pit fluids or just rainwater from severe rains and any actions that would be required. As a result of that meeting, the requirements are as follows:

- 1. Submit C-141 for potential release.
- 2. After pit contents are removed, delineate the extent of release by sampling
- 3. Sampling will include: the 5 point sampling and a sample taken from each spot where liner was compromised down to background or 250 ppm.
- 4. Remediation/Clean up will be determined after the sampling has been completed.
- 5. NMOCD- Artesia office is to be notified at the time of pit content removal and sampling.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of an Initial Report C-141 reporting a potential release from the drilling pit at the above referenced well site. The potential release is due to the liner being breached.

The conditions of approval of the C-141 are as follows;

- At the time of pit closure, delineation samples are to be obtained for analyses. (Laboratory analysis required for final confirmation samples).
- In the event contaminants are determined to be present, submit a remediation work plan proposal based on contaminant delineation results, site ranking, and OCD Rules and Guidelines.
- Notify the OCD 24 hours prior to commencement of operations.
- Notify the OCD 24 hours prior to obtaining samples where analyses of samples obtained are to be submitted to the OCD.
- Submit a Final Report C-141 and/or pit closure report upon satisfactory completion of activities.
