



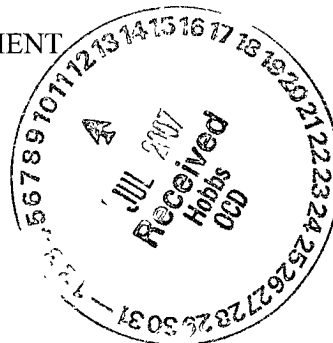

Please submit a Final Abandonment Notice, Form 3160-5, original and five copies. The report should state that all requirements have been met and final reclamation will occur at facility closure.


