## I. DRILLING OPERATIONS REQUIREMENTS:

- A. The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is to be notified a minimum of 4 hours in advance for a representative to witness:
  - 1. Spudding well
  - 2. Setting and/or Cementing of all casing strings
  - 3. BOPE tests
    - Eddy County call the Carlsbad Field Office, 620 East Greene St., Carlsbad, NM 88220, (505) 361-2822
- B. Although Hydrogen Sulfide has not been reported in this section, it has been reported in the township to the east in Sections 17, 20, and 21 measuring 1600-10000 ppm in the gas stream and 20-4000 ppm in STVs. A Hydrogen Sulfide drilling operation plan has been attached to the APD.
- C. Unless the production casing has been run and cemented or the well has been properly plugged, the drilling rig shall not be removed from over the hole without prior approval.

#### II. CASING:

- A. The 13-3/8 inch surface casing shall be set a minimum of 25 feet into the Rustler Anhydrite and above the salt at approximately 375 feet and cemented to the surface.
  - 1. If cement does not circulate to the surface, the appropriate BLM office shall be notified and a temperature survey utilizing an electronic type temperature survey with a surface log readout will be used or a cement bond log shall be run to verify the top of the cement.
  - 2. Wait on cement (WOC) time for a primary cement job will be a minimum of 18 hours for a water basin or 500 pounds compression strength, whichever is greater. (This is to include the lead cement)
  - 3. Wait on cement (WOC) time for a remedial job will be a minimum of 4 hours after bringing cement to surface or 500 pounds compression strength, whichever is greater.
  - 4. If cement falls back, remedial action will be done prior to drilling out that string.

Possible lost circulation in the Grayburg and San Andres formations. Possible water flows in the Salado and Artesia groups.

- B. The minimum required fill of cement behind the <u>8-5/8</u> inch intermediate casing is cement shall circulate to surface. If cement does not circulate see A.1 thru 4.
- C. The minimum required fill of cement behind the <u>5-1/2</u> inch production casing is cement shall circulate to surface. If cement does not circulate see A.1 thru 4.
- **D.** If hardband drill pipe is rotated inside casing; returns will be monitored for metal. If metal is found in samples, drill pipe will be pulled and rubber protectors which have a larger diameter than the tool I joints of the drill pipe will be installed prior to continuing drilling operations.

### **III. PRESSURE CONTROL:**

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- A. All blowout preventer (BOP) and related equipment (BOPE) shall comply with well control requirements as described in Onshore Oil and Gas Order No. 2 and API RP 53 Section 17.
- **B.** Minimum working pressure of the blowout preventer (BOP) and related equipment (BOPE) required for drilling below the surface casing shoe shall be 2000 (2M) PSI.
- C. Minimum working pressure of the blowout preventer (BOP) and related equipment (BOPE) required for drilling below the 8-5/8" intermediate casing shoe shall be 2000 (2M) PSI.
- **D.** The appropriate BLM office shall be notified a minimum of 4 hours in advance for a representative to witness the tests.
  - 1. The tests shall be done by an independent service company.
  - 2. The results of the test shall be reported to the appropriate BLM office.
  - 3. All tests are required to be recorded on a calibrated test chart. A copy of the BOP/BOPE test chart and a copy of independent service company test will be submitted to the appropriate BLM office.
  - 4. The BOP/BOPE test shall include a low pressure test from 250 to 300 psi. The test will be held for a minimum of 10 minutes if test is done with a test plug and 30 minutes without a test plug.
  - 5. A variance to test the surface casing and BOP/BOPE to the reduced pressure of <u>1500</u> psi with a 3<sup>rd</sup> party tester is approved.
