Dear Mr. Hudson:

Reference is made to the following:

(a) Devon Energy Production Company, L.P.'s ("Devon" or "applicant") application for a non-standard well location (*administrative application referenece No. pCLP0719845385*) for the Strawberry 7 Federal Com Well No. 2 that was submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe, New Mexico on July 16, 2007; and

(b) the Division's records pertinent to your request.

The applicant requests approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its existing Strawberry 7 Federal Com Well No. 2 in the North Hackberry-Bone Spring Pool (Oil – 97056) which is located 1300 feet from the North line and 1750 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 7, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The NW/4 NE/4 of Section 7 is to be dedicated to the well in the North Hackberry-Bone Spring Pool forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

The North Hackberry-Bone Spring Pool is currently governed by Division Rule No. 19.15.3.104(B).


Evidence submitted by the applicant demonstrates that the Strawberry 7 Federal Com Well No. 2 was originally drilled as a Morrow test well at a standard gas well location, and that the well will now be re-completed to the Bone Spring interval.

The applicant has provided notice of this application to all affected offset operators and/or interest owners. No party has entered an objection to this application within the 20-day waiting period prescribed by Division Rule 19.15.3.104(F).

Division records show that there are no other wells producing from the North Hackberry-Bone Spring Pool within the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 7.

Pursuant to the authority granted under the provisions of Division Rule 19.15.3.104.F(2), the above-described unorthodox oil well location in the North Hackberry-Bone Spring Pool is hereby approved.
