Marbob Energy has conducted a review to determine if an H2S contingency plan is required for the above referenced wells. We were able to conclude that any potential hazardous volume would be minimal. H2S concentrations of wells in these areas from surface to TD are low enough; therefore we do not believe that an H2S Contingency Plan would be necessary.
