
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The cause of the problem was a leaking water line into the fiberglass water storage tank on location. The line has been replaced, the tank battery moved to a new site, and the pumper on the lease replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The area affected included the area immediately surrounding the water storage tank and involved an area approximately 20' wide by 50' long. Excavation ensued removing material from an area 20' wide by 50' long to a depth of 4' and taking said material to an approved landfarm. The area was delineated revealing unacceptable TPH levels to a depth of 18' bgs on the east side of the site. Further excavation proceeded, with OCD approval, removing approximately 150 square yards of material to a depth of 18' bgs on the east side of the site. Said material was taken to an approved landfarm. A 40 ml polyethylene impervious liner was installed over the bottom of the entire excavated area. The pit was then filled with clean caliche material and topsoil and contoured to the lay of the land.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
