RE: Subsequent Report, Reclamation, Final Inspection

Subsequent Report is being returned for further actions.

1. This office was not notified prior to start, removal of equipment or for seeding as specified in the written notice of May 25, 2008. Provide seeding date.
2. COG did a good job of removing equipment and the caliche from the well location.
3. The oil contaminated soils still exist around the facility, and needs to be removed.
4. The barricade that was to be installed between the facility and the reclaimed area has not been installed. This requirement is to prevent any contaminants from the facility from entering the playa.
5. There are two areas to the east of the facility where poly flow lines have leaked oil and produced water. One is actually in the playa and the other is just out of it, but on the upslope of the playa. These areas need to be removed and the poly lines addressed to prevent future events.
6. You may need to establish a turn-around for oil transports. Keep earthen barricade between these areas and the disturbed surfaces.
