Iso Scanner Bond Log showed cement up to 290'. From that point, tool did not get good signals. Thus TOC is in the interval 0-290'. Gauge on annulus show no pressure.

9/19/08 MIRU to attempt 1" cement from TOC to surface. Could not pull enough stretch to get slips out. Shut down.

We plan to complete the well with 6 stages fracture stimulation through casing. Estimated start of completion is 4 weeks.

Remedial cement work required after completion.
