Violation of NMOCD Rule 19.15.9.704.A (5), which states in part "...The injection well operator shall advise the division of the date and time any initial, five-year or special tests are to be

commenced in order that such tests may be witnessed."

Original notification letter stating the due date of these inspections was sent out on November 3, 2008.

Failure to contact the OCD by Corrective Action due date to schedule the required inspection on this well will require that this well be shut-in on the Corrective Action due date.



In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by the "Corrective Action Due By:" date shown above, further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Divison Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of CIVIL PENALTIES for your violation of OCD rules.
