Fasken Oil and Ranch, Ltd. is making application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Non-Standard Proration Unit for the El Paso Federal No. 4. The well currently produces from the Avalon Morrow under Administrative Order NSP-987. This approval is necessary as Fasken is applying to the Bureau of Land Management to recomplete the well to the Avalon Strawn and Calabaza Draw Atoka, and then downhole commingle the Strawn and Atoka with the Morrow. A separate downhole commingle application is being filed today with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Santa Fe Office.

Attached for your review is a copy of the original C-102 showing the variation in the legal sub-division in the north half of Section 3. This well location is standard as it is approximately 300' from the quarter/quarter section line.

Your approval of this non-standard proration unit is requested at your earliest convenience. This recompletion and downhole commingle project will commence as soon as all approvals are received.

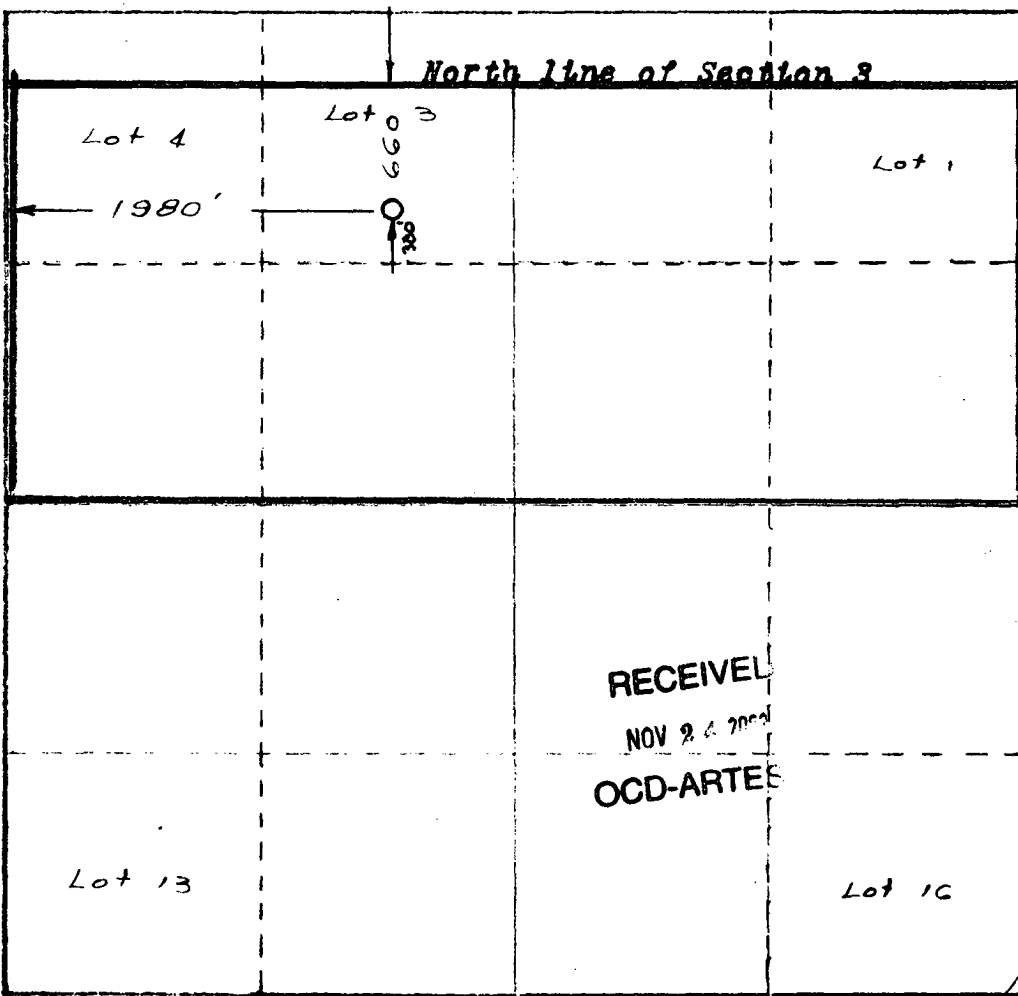
