

LOCATED IN SEC 2, T7S, R22E IN
CHAVES COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

NO HYDROGEN SULFIDE OR OTHER HAZARDOUS GASES OR FLUIDS HAVE BEEN ENCOUNTERED, REPORTED OR KNOWN TO EXIST AT THIS DEPTH IN THIS AREA.

NEW MEXICO "CS" STATE #3B

This is an open drilling site. H2S monitoring equipment and emergency response equipment will be used within 500' of zones known to contain H2S, including warning signs, wind indicators and H2S monitor. Pumpers carry (MICROPACKS) H2S pocket testers at all times. Pulling units has an H2S indicator that puts off light and alarm of any indication of H2S being present.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the case of a release of gas containing H2S, the first responder must isolate the area and prevent entry by other persons into the 100 ppm ROE. Additionally the first responder must evacuate any public spaces encompassed by the 100 ppm ROE. First responder must take care not to injure themselves during the operation. Company and or local officials must be contacted to aid in this operation. Evacuation of the public should be beyond the 100 ppm ROE.

All responders must have training in the detection of H2S measures for protection against the gas, equipment used for protection and emergency response. Additionally, responders must be equipped with H2S monitors and air packs on order to control the release. Use the "buddy system" to ensure no injuries occur during the response.

IGNITION OF GAS SOURCE

Should control of the well be considered lost and ignition considered, take care to protect against exposure of sulfur Dioxide (SO2). Intentional ignition must be coordinated with the NMOCD and local officials. Additionally the NM State Police may become involved. NM State Police shall be the Incident Command on scene of any major release. Take care to protect downwind whenever there is an ignition of the gas.

CONTACTING AUTHORITIES

Agencies will ask for information such as type and volume of release, wind direction, location of release, etc. be prepared with all information available. The following call list of essential and potential responders must be in coordination with the State of New Mexico's Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Plan (HMER).
