Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

While excavating material during a plug and abandon process, a historic spill was uncovered. It is unclear when or where the spill originated from. Due to the nature of the spill being historic there were no free liquids to recover.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

An approximate size of 20' x 60' was impacted. The impacted area is located beneath what was an oil tank. Soil from the pooling areas was excavated and disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility. Crew excavated contaminated soils; soils were placed directly into waiting trucks. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will taken and analysis ran for TPH, BTEX and Chlorides once all contaminated material has been removed. **Depth to Ground Water: <50' (approx. 40', per New Mexico Office of the State Engineer); Wellhead Protection Area: No; Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000'; SITE RANKING IS 20. Based on site ground water quality and enclosed analytical results.**
