Reference is made to the following:

(a) your application (**administrative application reference No. pTGW10-22847513**) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on August 16, 2010, and

(b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

Burnett Oil Co., Inc. (Burnett) has requested to drill the above-referenced well at an unorthodox oil well location, described above in the caption of this letter. The NE/4 SW/4 of Section 11 will be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 40-acre spacing unit in the Loco Hills; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (96718). This pool is governed by statewide Rule 15.9.A, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 330 feet from the southern unit boundary.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 and 4.12.A(2).
