- (a) your application (administrative application reference No. pDKB08-21338056) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on July 31, 2008, and
 - (b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

Devon Energy Production Company (Devon) has requested to drill the above-referenced well at an unorthodox oil well location, described above in the caption of this letter. The SW/4 SW/4 of Section 32 will be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 40-acre spacing unit in the undesignated Happy Valley-Delaware Pool (29665). This pool is governed by statewide Rule 104.B(1), which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary.
