Designation of Successor Operator, Communitization Agreement No. NMNM 071184, covering the UL "F" Sec. 34, T. 17S, R. 27E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

This indenture, dated as to the 24th day of August, 2010, by and between Chesapeake Operating, Inc., and Three Rivers Operating Company, hereinafter designated as "First Party," and the owners of communitized working interest, hereinafter designated as "Second Parties."

Witnesseth: Whereas under the provision of section 17(j) of the Act of February 25, 1920, as amended (74 Stat. 784; 30 U.S.C. 266(J)), and by authority delegated, Chesapeake Operating on the 9th day of April, 2010, approved communitization agreement no.
