Gentlemen:

The North Shugart Queen Unit, No. NM-71000X, Eddy County, New Mexico, automatically terminated effective January 1, 2011, pursuant to 43 CFR 3186.1.20.c which states the following:

"this agreement shall remain in effect for such term and so long thereafter as unitized substance can be produced in quantities sufficient to pay for the cost of producing same from wells on unitized land within any participating area established hereunder. Should production cease and diligent drilling or reworking operations to restore production or new production are not in progress within 60 days and production is not restored or should new production not be obtain in paying quantities on committed lands within this unit area, this agreement will automatically terminate effective the last day of the month in which the last unitized production occurred."

And under Article XXI paragraph 21.3 of the unit agreement which states the following:

"The term of this agreement shall be for and during the time that unitized substance are produced in quantities sufficient to pay for the cost of producing the same from wells on the unitized land and so long thereafter as drilling, reworking or other operations (including secondary recovery operations) are prosecuted thereon without cessation of more than ninety (90) consecutive days, and so long thereafter as unitized substance are produced as aforesaid."
