Inspection Results: Issues identified

1. Pit contaminants (salts and cuttings) impacting the restoration of the location. To include area to the north of the DHM and along the western edge of the location.

These issues will need to be addressed prior to Final Abandonment. We still have excess materials on the south side of the access road that could be utilized for capping material. It would be good to address prior to the monsoonal flow.
